OHIO RIVER GREENWAY TRAIL

The Ohio River Greenway Trail (ORGT) is a multi-use corridor, which is a key segment of an extensive trail system being developed in the "Keystone State." The green trail is also serving to complete an essential section in a nationally, significant linear park system, called the "Industrial Heartland Trail," through the interconnection of existing trails in five states – Maryland, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, and West Virginia, as well as a link to the "Great American Rail Trail."

THREE RIVERS HERITAGE AND WATER TRAILS

The Friends of the Riverfront works to protect and restore the riverfront in the Pittsburgh region through the development and stewardship of the Three Rivers Heritage and Water Trails. The Three Rivers Heritage Trail is a 24-mile urban riverfront trail system along the Allegheny, Monongahela, and Ohio in Allegheny County. The Three Rivers Water Trail is a system of 23 access points for non-motorized recreational boats on the Allegheny, Monongahela, Ohio, and Youghiogheny Rivers. The trails connects visitors to opportunities for recreation and commuting for both residents and visitors, and allows access to dense urban areas, popular shopping and entertainment districts.

BICYCLEPA ROUTE A

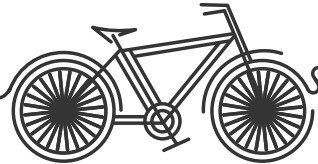
BicyclePA is a series of bicycle routes created by PennDOT to cross the state on highways and rail trails. The 199-mile BicyclePA Route A runs from the West Virginia border south of Mount Morris in Greene County north to Coraopolis, Monaca, Beaver Falls, and ends in Presque Isle State Park on Lake Erie in Erie, Pennsylvania.

MONTOUR TRAIL

The Montour Trail is a multi-use, non-motorized recreational pathway around Pittsburgh, the country's longest suburban rail-trail. The main line extends about 47-miles; branch routes increase length to over 60-miles. The relatively flat route stretches from Coraopolis along the Ohio River to Clairton on the Monongahela River. A northwest branch connects directly to the Pittsburgh International Airport.

UNDERGROUND RAILROAD BICYCLE ROUTE

The Adventure Cycling Association Underground Railroad Bicycle Route (UGRR) memorializes a network of clandestine routes by which African freedom seekers attempted to escape slavery before and during the Civil War. The 153-mile UGRR Pittsburgh Spur runs between Pittsburgh, Coraopolis, Monaca, Beaver Falls, and Erie, Pennsylvania.

Coraopolis, Pa HONORING TRADITION AND EMBRACING PROGRESS

CORAOPOLIS IS A BOROUGH IN ALLEGHENY COUNTY ALONG THE OHIO RIVER, 14-MILES NORTHWEST OF PITTSBURGH.

As the trailhead for three different trails – Montour Trail, Ohio River Greenway Trail and the Three Rivers Heritage Trail – Coraopolis is a dream destination for walkers, hikers and cyclists. The town's waterways are part of the Three Rivers Water Trail, a National Recreation Trail. The appeal of "Cory" goes far beyond its natural amenities. With sidewalk-lined streets, historic architecture, and charming shops, visitors will appreciate its eclectic mix of retail, food, and beverage establishments as well. During your time here, you will notice the beautiful stone churches and cobblestone streets that flank the business district. Your visit through town will pass by the Coraopolis Train Station, an original Richardsonian Romanesque design, and a listing on the National Register of Historic Places. For decades, the station lay vacant and unused, but it has become the focal point of a huge fundraising effort in recent years to return it to a state of glory in the heart of town. As an important destination on the "Little Giant" Pittsburgh & Lake Erie Railroad, the railroad brought industry, people, and promise to the former "Middletown" village, which was renamed as the maiden city "Coraopolis" in 1886. Rather than an homage to Greek Goddess Persephone, folklore suggests that the town was actually named after first Mayor Josiah Dillon's love interest at the time, neighborhood socialite Cora Watson. While you are in Coraopolis, do not miss checking out the views at Susie Letteri Riverfront Park and the new AHN Montour Health and Sports Medicine Center. Neighboring Neville Island is home to Robert Morris University Sports Center, a 32-acre state-of-the-art facility open to the public year-round.

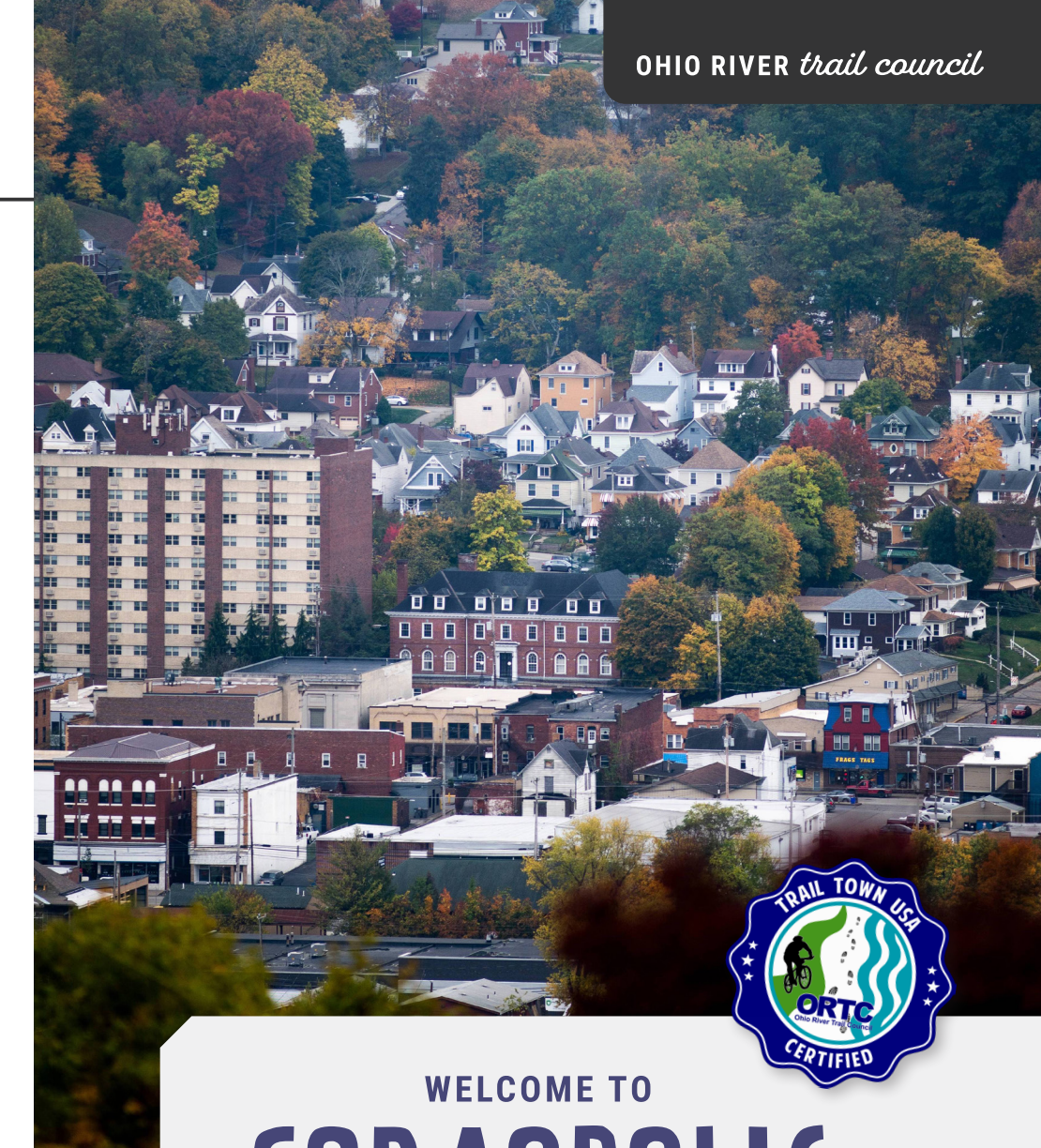
